Thank you for the above consultation.

We have **no objection** to this application on the grounds of flood risk.

We view the Flood Risk Assessment conducted in 2019 for the site at the PPP stage (19/00182/PPP) to be based on appropriate methods and its representation of flood risk at the site is in line with all other evidence that is currently available.

The proposed building footprint is outwith the functional floodplain.

The FRA recommended that finished floor levels should be a minimum of 159.02m AOD, based on the 1 in 200 year + climate change level and 600mm freeboard. Therefore, the finished floor levels of 159.1m AOD - shown in drawings 20121(PL)010 & 20121(PL)011 - are appropriate based on the findings of the FRA.
